

GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The first SAKOM Meeting of the Board of Directors during last year was held on March 6, 2020. This Meeting, which set a stone for SAKOM's new goals and activity in general, was marked by a expansion of the SAKOM's membership.

The Board examined and approved membership applications submitted by prominent companies such as *Ferbild*, *BS Telecom Solutions*, *Elektromontaza*, *Elektrovat*, *West-gradnja*, *Unogradnja*, *DIS Niskogradnja*, *Stepcon*, *Naftachem*, *Europolis*, *and one individual membership application submitted by a lawyer Mr. Branko Armenko*.

The first ever executed Online Meeting of the Board of Directors, befell on October 6, 2020. This is the meeting that marked the SAKOM's launch of its scholarship programme. As per its Agenda, the Board discussed and approved the scholarship in amount of 100 EUR per month to sisters Marta and Nikolija Galjak.

The sisters are full-time self-financing students attending the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Biology (Marta Galjak) and the Faculty of Medicine (Nikolija Galjak). Marta and Nikolija grew up in Kososvo in a multicultural and multi-religious environment, which has had a positive impact on their social development. Unfortunately, their father passed away in 2014 and since then they have been supported only by their mother, who lives in Kosovska Mitrovica. Nevertheless, sisters have shown remarkable academic success and tremendous desire to continue their education.

Furthermore, during this meeting the Board has agreed with an idea of updating the design and content of SAKOM website. The result of this decision is shown in the Website section of the Report.

The second Online Meeting of the Board of Directors was convened on December 8, 2020. The Board has come up with another scholarship decision, namely granting scholarships to Milena Lazarević and Jovana Ristić, who are attending the elective course 'Azerbaijani Language' at the Faculty of Philology, University of Belgrade, in the monthly amount of 100 EUR starting from December 1, 2020, until November 30, 2021.

The Faculty of Philology's commission nominated the candidates, and their scholarship applications were supported, among other required documentation, by a letter of recommendation of the candidates' lecturer, confirming their academic success and material need for additional support in the form of scholarship.

It is important to note that the Board did not only approve two more scholarships, aiming to promote the Republic of Serbia and Republic of Azerbaijan's cultural exchange but also encouraged the provision of crucially needed help to the health workers of the Hospital-Clinical Center KBC ZEMUN.
